# Capital District Transportation Authority Community and Stakeholder Relations Committee Meeting Minutes – March 21, 2024 at 11:15 am; Microsoft Teams & 110 Watervliet Ave

#### **Meeting Purpose**

Regular monthly meeting of the Community and Stakeholder Relations Committee. Committee Chair Stackrow noted that a quorum was present. Minutes from the February 22, 2024 meeting were reviewed and approved.

#### **Administrative Discussion Items**

- Jon Scherzer provided an update on Season 8 of CDPHP Cycle! The season will kick off in the next week or so (barring no more tricks by mother nature!). It will feature 400 e-bikes and 200 pedal bikes at nearly 100 stations across the Capital Region. During 2024, we will expand into Bethlehem and the City of Rensselaer, add 200 new e-bikes along with 10 new stations.
- Emily DeVito provided an update on our employee app. BLINK was introduced to the workforce in 2022 to help communicate with employees. Note the majority of our workforce do not have company email addresses.
- Currently, nearly 80% of the workforce is engaged with the app. BLINK provides company news as well as a HUB section where employees can access forms and HR information. We continue to promote the app and build content with a goal of reaching 85% participation by the two-year anniversary in June.
- Jaime Kazlo provided the Earned Media and Community Relations report. Over the last month we earned 10 media placements in television, newspaper, and radio with an estimated value of \$10,000. Stories focused on our annual State of CDTA and workforce development.
- We participated in local events including the Capital Region Chamber's Annual Dinner where we received the 2024 Changemaker Award. We hosted students from Questar BOCES at our Troy facility, and we celebrated our workforce on Transit Employee Appreciation Day on March 18.
- Jaime outlined social media engagement for the month. We saw an increase in followers
  across our social media channels. Top posts included a Congratulations to Creighton
  Manning Engineering for winning an Engineering Award for their work on our Purple
  Line.
- Looking ahead, we will provide transportation for the annual Dr. King Career Fair, host our annual employee safety awards celebration, and participate in the CDPHP workforce challenge in May.




## **Saratoga Summer Trolley**

- Will operate to support Belmont Stakes
- Service will be presented fare free by the Saratoga
   Casino Hotel and NYRA
- Routing along Broadway, while offering a park and ride option to the Race Course
- Operates June through September 2, 2024
- Two trolleys provide 30-minute frequency from
   12pm to 10pm from Wednesday through Sunday
- Historically averages 20,000 trips per year







## **Grafton State Park**

- Service operates from late June through Labor Day, providing four round trip opportunities Wednesday through Sunday
- More than 1,000 boardings last year





# Lake George Trolley 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Season

- This service is part of the GGFT Merger
- Important operation that connects Glens Falls,
   Queensbury and Lake George Village
- Will begin operating Memorial Day and run through the end of the tourism season in October





- Connects Albany residents to green spaces including Five Rivers Environmental Center and Thatcher State Park
- Fare free service operates on Saturdays between
   Memorial Day and Indigenous Peoples Day
- Partnership with the Mohawk Land Conservancy
   that operates between 9am and 5pm on Saturdays
- Will expand the Schenectady pilot program through the summer connecting Electric City residents to Central Park and the Pinebush Discovery Center
- Roughly 1,000 boardings in 2023





#### CDPHP announces e-bikes available for use

 $\label{eq:continuous} A \text{ pr. 2-ALBANY, N.Y.} - \text{The Capital District Transportation Authority (CDTA) and CDPHP have annotation of their eighth annual "Cycle!" bike rental season, with the availability of electric bikes.$ 

As of today, which is the earliest ever launch of "Cycle!", both electric bikes (e-bikes) and pedal bikes will for use in Albany, Schenectady, and Troy. Over the next few weeks, bikes will be added to additional local including Saratoga Springs and points north.

Over 600 bikes will be available this season, including 200 e-bikes. More than ten new rental/return static added throughout the region, and CDPHP is introducing new technology that will make bike rental faster An updated CDPHP Cycle! app, which is available on the App Store and Google Play, is free to download


