OVERVIEW

CDTA worked with Saratoga County customers, elected officials, businesses, service providers and other key stakeholders on this. The restructured route plan that will provide better connections and make service more efficient.

NEW NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICE



Route #450 (Schenectady – Saratoga – Wilton via Route 50)

This route will operate from Schenectady to Wilton along Route 50 through Scotia, Burnt Hills, Ballston Spa and Saratoga Springs. The route will operate Monday through Saturday from 4:45am to 1:15am, and on Sundays from 8:00am to 8:15pm. The route offers connections to BusPlus and the other routes at SCCC/Liberty Park Station. Some trips will deviate to Quad Graphics. *Route #450 replaces portions of Routes #50 and #472.*



Route #451 (Ballston Spa – West Saratoga via Terraces)

This route will travel between Ballston Spa, downtown Saratoga Springs, on the west side of the city offering service to surrounding neighborhoods. Key destinations include the Saratoga County Department of Social Services, Quad Graphics, Jefferson and Vanderbilt Terraces, Saratoga Springs Train Station, and the Naval Support Unit. The route will operate Monday through Saturday from 6:15am to 8:00pm, and on Sundays from 9:15am to 5pm. Connections to Route #450 can be made in Ballston Spa along Route 50 and in Downtown Saratoga at Broadway and Lake Street. *Route* #451 replaces portions of Routes #50, #472, and #473.



Route #452 (Skidmore – Downtown Saratoga – Wilton)

This route will provide service to Skidmore College, downtown Saratoga Springs, and Wilton. This route will travel to Embury Apartments, Clinton Street, Circular Street and Excelsior Avenue. The route will operate Monday through Saturday from 6:30am to 10:30pm, and 8:15am to 6:30pm on Sundays. Service will be extended later into the evening between Skidmore and downtown. *Route #452 replaces portions of Routes #50 and #473*.

AREAS WITH ADJUSTED SERVICE

Embury Apartments – Route #452 will provide 90 minute frequency instead of every 30 minutes.

Jefferson & Vanderbilt Terraces – Route #451 will provide 60 minute frequency during the weekday peaks (6a-10a, 3p-6p) and 120 minute frequency weekday off-peaks and weekends. Service will now travel along Vanderbilt Street, Worth Street, and Jefferson Street.

Saratoga Rail Station – Route #451 will provide 60 minute frequency during the weekday peaks (6a-10a, 3p-6p) and 120 minute frequency weekday off-peaks and weekends.

Rowland Street & Geyser Road – Route #451 will provide 60 minute frequency during the weekday peaks (6a-10a, 3p-6p) and 120 minute frequency weekday off-peaks and weekends.
