Meeting Purpose

Regular monthly meeting of the Board Operations Committee. Jayme Lahut noted that a quorum was present. Minutes from the September 15, 2021 meeting were reviewed and approved.

Administrative Discussion Items

- The committee reviewed agendas for the meetings in October.
- Our Board Retreat will be on November 19 at The Desmond. Mark Aesch from TransPro will share his insight on measuring value and relevance. As we know, ridership cannot be the central component of our performance reports. Mobility options and community involvement needs to be measured and be reported on. We are committed to expansion and providing great customer experiences as we move out of the pandemic. The retreat discussion will focus on this.

IT has provided employees with educational opportunities that are constant and consistent. They are designed to get employees to learn about the red flags that come with cyber-attacks and how to keep CDTA secure.
