Administrative Discussion Items

- Jonathan Scherzer provided an update on the newly rolled-out FLEX micro transit pilot program. CDTA launched FLEX on January 3, 2020. FLEX offers flexible routing and scheduling that allows users to book a trip through a mobile app, similar to rideshare.
- FLEX continues to grow its ridership through customers use, word of mouth, and marketing efforts by CDTA. To date, more than 300 passengers have taken trips and 4,000 miles have been logged.
- Jaime Watson summarized the monthly Community Engagement report and provided a 2019 year-in-review. In total CDTA had 174 earned media placements in television, newspaper and radio. Many of the stories highlighted in 2019 focused on CDTA's community partnerships, electric buses and new services.
- Jaime discussed themes, projects and goals for CDTA's communication and community engagement activities over the next year.
