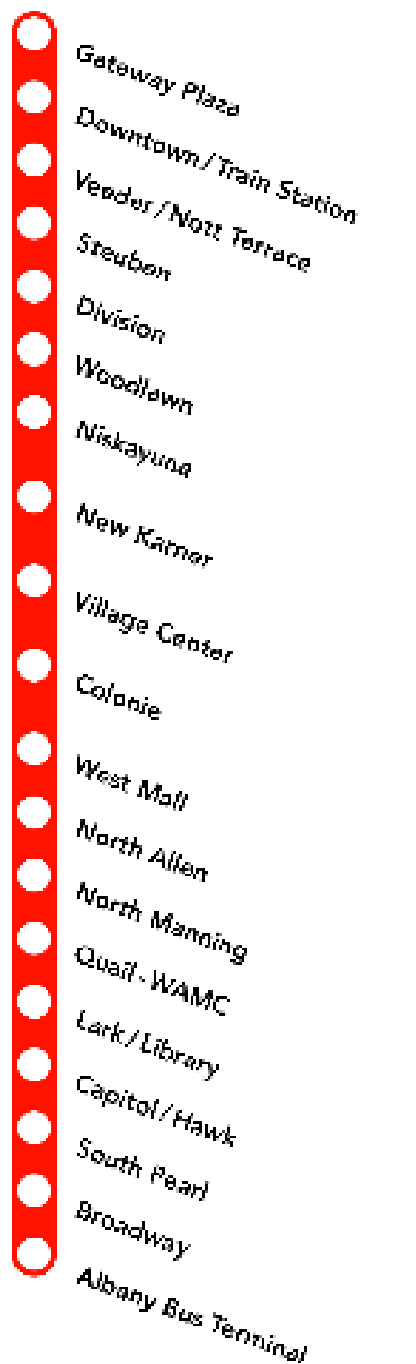

What Does It Cost to Ride BusPlus?

The BusPlus fare is \$2 for cash customers. CDTA riders who use Navigator smart card or mobile app fare products pay \$1.50 or less per ride.

Can I Still Take Local Service on Route 5?

All local service meets at the Colonie BusPlus stations and offers connections for customers who need to extend their trip.

- Route #1 makes stops at all local bus stops on its route along with pickups and drop-offs at BusPlus stations.
Route #355 operates on Route 5 between Schenectady and the Colonie Station...

Navigator

Pay As You Go - Costs just \$1.30 for the first three rides, while the fourth and up are free for the rest of the transit day.

Frequent Rider - Valid for unlimited access to CDTA’s regular route network for 31 days from the first day of use (\$65.00)

Half Fare Navigator**..... \$32.50 (Frequent Rider)

**Citizens age 65 and over, disabled individuals, Medicare card and CDTA half-fare ID cardholders are entitled to ride for half-fare on CDTA’s fixed route service.

*Children 46" and under ride free when accompanied by a fare paying adult. The limit is three children per adult.
