Where can I purchase bus passes and tokens?

Multi-ride passes may be purchased at Glens Falls City Hall or by contacting the CDTA Glens Falls office. Single ride tokens can be purchased by businesses and agencies for their customers and clients as they have been.

Citizens age 60 and over, disabled individuals, Medicare card holders, and veterans – are entitled to ride for half fare on CDTA’s fixed route service.

CDTA’s policy is to be fully compliant with Title VI of the 1964 Civil Right Act, which states that no one shall be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of or discriminated against due to race, color, or national origin. Riding With CDTA

CDTA has installed more than 200 new bus stops across the service network to enhance safety and improve operations. Plan on arriving at your stop at least five to 10 minutes before your scheduled departure when possible. Make sure you know the route number and schedule of the bus you will be taking. Plus, make sure that you are on the correct side of the street and stand up as the bus approaches to signal to the operator that you are ready to board.
